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"This encapsulates the excitement of the sunrise on Llanddwyn Island, Anglesey, with the morning sun hitting the lighthouse of Twr Mawr," says Drew Buckley. "It was a long walk to get to this location for dawn. Timing it right with the tide also proved tricky, with the last of the high tide remaining, which made for a bit of a water crossing from Newborough
