Notes

EOS 1D/1Ds series cameras

The EOS professional models are not listed in the table above because they all have built-in battery grips, complete with a second set of controls for shooting in the portrait format. The cameras use a battery pack (Ni-MH or Lithium-ion, depending on model) which slides in from the side of the camera. Size AA batteries cannot be fitted.

EOS 1100D

There is a Battery Grip BG-E9, and a BG-E11, but no BG-E10. Logically, this would be the grip for the EOS 1100D, but there is no grip for this camera mentioned in the instruction manual, nor in any Canon listing. If you do an internet search for BG-E10 you will find quite a few compatible from third-party manufacturers, but so far we have not seen a genuine Canon BG-E10 grip. Our guess is that Canon feels there will be insufficient demand for a grip to fit this entry-level model, but has left its options open.
